## RECYCLE USED AUTOMOTIVE MATERIALS

Automotive Materials Stewardship (AMS) provides a free, safe and easy way to drop off used antifreeze, oil filters and oil containers for recycling.



### ANTIFREEZE

Fluid and containers with capacity of 30L or less



### OIL CONTAINERS

That have a capacity of 30L or less and were manufactured/used for the purpose of containing lubricating oil



### OIL FILTERS

After they have been used for their intended purpose

On behalf of its producer customers, AMS helps create convenient, environmentally sustainable ways for consumers and businesses to recycle automotive waste and divert these materials from landfill.

## WHAT HAPPENS TO COLLECTED MATERIALS?

AMS safely manages antifreeze, oil containers and oil filters to end-of-life, diverting harmful substances from landfill and waterways.



### ANTIFREEZE AND OIL CONTAINERS

Empty plastic antifreeze and oil containers are collected from across the province and delivered to an AMS service provider partner for processing. The containers are shredded and washed, with any oil residue captured and refined into oil products. The plastic is recycled into new products like plumbing pipe, rail ties, deck boards and park benches.



### OIL FILTERS

After being collected and delivered to an AMS service provider partner, oil filters are sorted, then crushed by a hydraulic press. Any remaining oil from the filters is recovered and refined into new lubricant. The metal casings are also recycled as scrap metal.
